Dr. Orehek will talk with Mary about the latest information on treating Parkinson's Disease. She also answers many common questions viewers have about this fairly widespread neurological condition, a disease that still does not have a confirmed cause. Dr. Orehek, who is also the Medical Director of the American Parkinson Disease Association, the Minnesota Chapter, discusses important research and the importance of exercise, too.

The interview will have multiple airings on Channel 6, and then it will be aired on several other cable systems including Duluth-Superior's PACT, SPNN and MTN. It will then be broadcast several times on public television's tpt, 2.2 which reaches the entire state of MN, all of North Dakota and western Wisconsin.
